## **GLO to Begin New Service to Destin-Fort Walton Beach from New Orleans**

**(New Orleans, LA)** – Starting on June 24, 2016, GLO will offer seasonal, non-stop service from Louis Armstrong International Airport (MSY) to Destin-Fort Walton Beach Airport (VPS). Service will be offered on Mondays and Fridays on select dates through September 5, 2016. Introductory “GLOFort” fares are now being offered at \$99 (round-trip required) with tax, fees, and three checked bags included.
