

In accordance with Federal Aviation Regulation Part 158 Passenger Facility Charges, section 158.24, the New Orleans Aviation Board hereby provides notification of its intent to amend several of its existing Passenger Facilities Charge (PFC) Applications at the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport.

PFC No. 35 – New Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Station

Description: Design and construction of a new ARFF station to replace the current facility

Justification: Previously approved

Amendment: Increase funding for eligible costs

PFC Level: \$4.50

Total PFC Revenue: \$16,216,241

PFC No. 66 – Noise Contour Mapping (Part 150) Study

Description: Study to evaluate the impact of aircraft noise from the Airport on surrounding neighborhoods

Justification: Previously approved

Amendment: Withdraw project

PFC Level: \$3.00

Total PFC Revenue: \$0

PFC No. 75 – Facility Improvement Program

Description: Replacement and upgrades to terminal mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems

Justification: Previously approved

Amendment: Add relevant scope elements and increase funding for eligible costs

PFC No. 77 – Baggage Handling System

Description: Upgrade and replace existing baggage handling systems in the East and West Terminals

Justification: Previously approved

PFC No. 78 – Concourse C and D Sterile Corridor

Description: Construction of a passenger corridor behind security

Justification: Previously approved

Amendment: Withdraw project

PFC No. 79 – New Airfield Lighting Vault

Description: Relocate and upgrade the airfield lighting vault

Justification: Previously approved

Amendment: Increase funding for eligible costs
