In your opinion, what are the 3 most important factors in creating a healthy work place environment? The 3 most important factors in creating a healthy work place environment is support, transparency and teamwork.

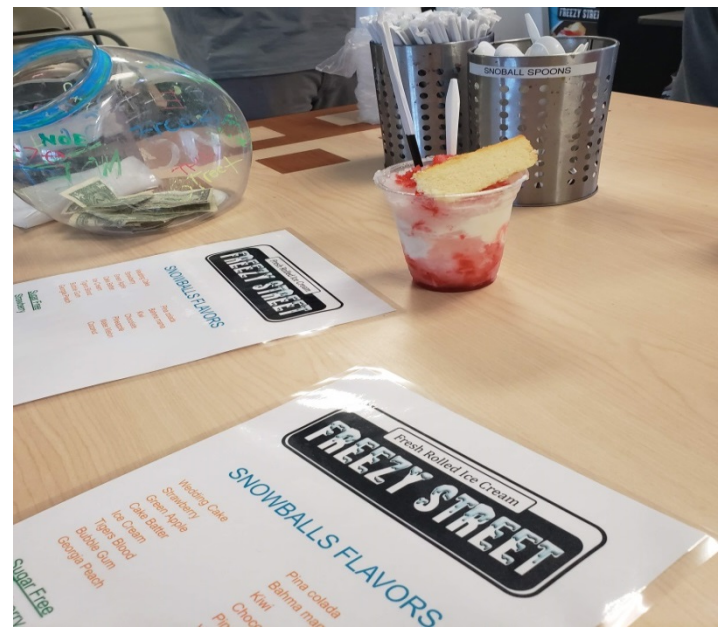
