



MSY Safety Policy Statement

Providing a safe and secure environment for our customers and employees is a core value of the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport (MSY). As part of our commitment, MSY maintains a Safety Management System (SMS) that enables the reporting of airside safety issues or concerns that are proactively addressed and resolved in a collaborative manner. An integral part of a successful SMS is reliance on each individual to participate in and improve airfield safety practices as part of their daily work activities.

To support an effective SMS and positive airfield safety culture, MSY commits to:

- Making safety the primary focus in all airside operations
- Providing senior management support together with the staff and resources needed to implement and maintain an effective SMS
- Continuously striving to highlight and improve safety throughout the movement and non-movement areas
- Encouraging employees to report airside safety issues without fear of retaliation
- Complying with applicable local, state, and federal regulatory requirements and standards related to airside safety

Safety is the responsibility of everyone working and operating in the movement and non-movement areas at MSY. While MSY is responsible for the development and organization of the SMS, its success depends on the involvement of all employees and stakeholders working in the airfield environs.
